The Douglas County Film Trail kicked off the start of the new year with another sign installation!



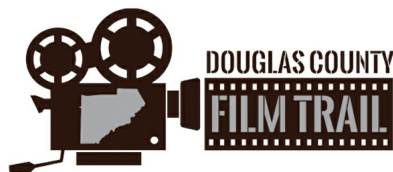
O'Neal Plaza
