The Douglasville Convention and Visitors Bureau (CVB) announced it has been awarded a Tourism Recovery Marketing Grant from Explore Georgia.

The Explore Georgia Tourism Recovery Marketing Grant program supports marketing efforts to bolster the recovery of Georgia's tourism industry from the COVID-19 pandemic. The Douglasville CVB was among 34 tourism entities across 27 counties who received a combined total of nearly \$1.5 million in recovery marketing funding as part of this one-time grant program.

Douglasville's recovery marketing campaign consists of several components – including, but not limited to, promoting Douglasville as a destination for Group Travel, using paid social advertising and marketing Douglasville as the premier destination for Sports Tourism.
