Playing 6,800 yards from the Championship tees, this “core” West Pines golf course features Crenshaw bent greens, four sets of tees to ensure an enjoyable experience for the golfers of all skill levels, a full practice range and putting green, and is situated less than 2 minutes off of I-20.

Of particular interest, is the "feel" of the West Pines golf course featuring rolling hills, and numerous wooded areas. With several adjoining fairways, the golf course has plenty of room to play and offers beautiful vistas throughout the round. Additionally, the close proximity of greens and tees minimizes time spent in walking/riding between holes, insuring rounds of 4 hours or less even on the busiest of days.

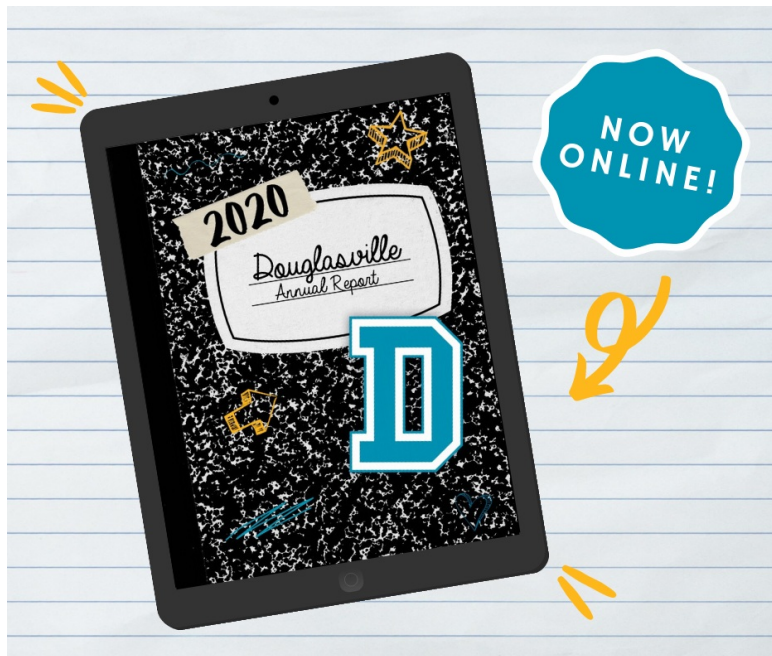
